

Parking in Oak Park

Below are options for parking within a few blocks of the 19th Century Club. All parking is free on Sundays.

19th Century Surface Lot

The spaces in this lot are available free of charge, unless reserved for staff or handicapped parking (see signs).

Parking update from the Nineteenth Century Club

As of March 1, 2018, parking in our lot is extremely limited, due to a recent increase in 24-hour reserved paid spaces. Please do not park in the row along the parking garage or the center row. We have rented those spaces. We have 6 spaces for visitors in the row closest to the Club. We encourage people to park in the parking garage or find street parking. Thanks for your understanding.

Lake and Forest Parking Garage

Entrance on Forest Avenue, immediately south of the Club's surface lot; \$4.00 for 3 to 3 ½ hours.

Street Parking

Forest Avenue north of the 19th Century Club

Ontario Street north of 19th Century Club

Lake Street south of 19th Century Club

Please be sure to read posted signs, as there are some time restrictions.

Holley Court Garage

Two blocks west of the 19th Century Club. North of Lake Street and east of Harlem Avenue. Entrances on Marion Street and on Ontario Street. Park in the garage, not the open surface lot (which is permit parking for residents of Brookdale, formerly Holley Court.)

Avenue Garage

Two blocks east and one block south of the 19th Century Club. East of Oak Park Avenue, south of Lake Street. Entrance on North Blvd, near the train overpass.
